Notice of Suspension and Withdrawal

We, the Antrustees and Senior Judges of the Sovereign International Court of Justice to hereby declare the following. Due to the recent investigations that has taken course by way of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), against Atlantis Gold Bank (www.atlantisgoldbank.org), we have now instructed both the Digital Reserve (www.digitalreserve.org) and First Republic Registrar foundation (FRRf)(www.frrf.org) to suspend and therefore withdraw all asset backing facilities and notarised sovereign documentation, until such time that the pending matters are fully resolved.

Items to be suspended and withdrawn include, but not limited to:



It is also ordered by the court that the webpage database for the presumed Kingdom of Atlantis be suspended from www.frrf.org, as to date there is no verified proof of claim of the existence and validity of Solomon Uchenna Wining's claims. FRRf is also withdrawn as the official Registrar for the alleged Kingdom of Atlantis.

OFFICIAL COURT STATEMENT

Withdrawal of First Republic Registrar foundation Officials

Date: 16th March 2026

This statement is issued by the Court to formally record that, following careful consideration and deliberation, a breakdown of trust and confidence has been identified in the operational relationship between the First Republic Registrar foundation (FRRf) and the relevant parties. This breakdown arises from the following specific matters:

1. Lack of Full Disclosure Regarding the Seized UKA Website: Atlantisgdbank.org

The Court notes that there has been a material failure to provide full and transparent disclosure in relation to the seizure of the United Kingdom of Atlantis website, Atlantisgdbank.org. FRRf officials were not appropriately informed, in breach of the reasonable expectation of openness within a collaborative institutional framework.

2. Safe Management of FRRf Funds for the Atlantis Gold Coin

The Court records concerns regarding the safe custody, stewardship, and management of FRRf funds designated for the Atlantis Gold Coin. The absence of adequate governance and accountability mechanisms in respect of these funds is noted as a matter of significant concern.

3. Inability to Secure an Adequate Liquidity Pool

The Court records that the responsible parties have demonstrated an inability to secure an adequate liquidity pool commensurate with the obligations and commitments made in connection with FRRf-related financial instruments and operations. This failure poses an ongoing risk to the integrity of those instruments.

In light of the above, the Court acknowledges and records the formal withdrawal of services by all FRRf officials, with immediate effect, as detailed in the accompanying FRRf Letter of Withdrawal dated 16th March 2026. This withdrawal is made without recourse, in compliance with FRRf Codes of Ethics and Conduct, and for the purpose of protecting the integrity of the First Republic Registrar foundation.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

RE: FORMAL WITHDRAWAL OF FRRf OFFICIALS WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT

We, the undersigned officials of the First Republic Registrar foundation (FRRf), write to formally notify you that, with immediate effect, we withdraw all FRRf services and the participation of all named officials from any and all engagements, arrangements, and responsibilities connected with the matter referenced above.

This decision has not been taken lightly. It is made in compliance with the FRRf Codes of Ethics and Conduct and is necessitated by a fundamental breakdown of trust and confidence arising from the following specific concerns, which have remained unresolved despite our best efforts:

1. Lack of Full Disclosure Regarding the Seized UKA Website: Atlantisgdbank.org

FRRf officials have not been provided with full and transparent disclosure in relation to the seizure of the United Kingdom of Atlantis website, Atlantisgdbank.org. This lack of openness is wholly inconsistent with the standards of transparency that the FRRf is required to uphold and that we have a duty to demand of our institutional partners.

2. Safe Management of FRRF Funds for the Atlantis Gold Coin

We have been unable to obtain the necessary assurances regarding the safe custody and proper management of FRRf funds designated for the Atlantis Gold Coin. The FRRf has a duty to protect the integrity of funds held under its oversight, and we cannot fulfil that duty where adequate governance is absent.

3. Inability to Secure an Adequate Liquidity Pool

A persistent inability to secure an adequate liquidity pool has been identified, placing the viability and credibility of FRRf-related financial instruments at serious risk. This represents a material failure in the obligations owed to those whose funds and interests the FRRf exists to safeguard.

In the circumstances, and in compliance with our obligations under the FRRf Codes of Ethics and Conduct, we hereby withdraw the services of all FRRf officials listed
